

## 2019 Texas Extreme Barrel Classic & Texas Ultimate Barrel Classic

### **RULES/ FAQ:**

**STALLS:** If you want to be stalled with another person, YOU MUST PUT ALL STALLS IN ONE person's name. No exceptions. You may bring your own shavings/pellets or purchase from the facility.

If you will be attending both races & need stalls only during the races weekends, we will leave you in the same stalls for both races so you will not have to re-bed stalls. In order to do so, stalls/rvs for both races must be paid for at the first race.

**NO REFUNDS ON STALLS OR RVS FOR ANY REASON.** You may Sell them yourself if for some reason you will not be using them.

**DRESS CODE:** Full Dress Code All Weekend: Jeans, Long sleeves, Hat or Helmet & Boots.

**FUTURITY RULES:** The Futurity is open to any horse, 4 or 5 years of age in 2019 that has not been entered in ANY barrel race competition prior to Dec 1, 2018. This would be foals of 2014 or 2015.

Futurity Payment Schedule - 1st payment of each respective Futurity must be postmarked by OCT 1 and the 2nd payment must be postmarked by NOV 1 and be paid in full.

Futurity Late Entries will be taken until 5pm Jan 2 for the Extreme & 5pm Jan 9 for the Ultimate with a \$200 Late Fee. Late Entries will be added to the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> go draw. Therefore, they will be 1<sup>st</sup> to run in the 2<sup>nd</sup> go as the draw order is reversed.

Rider changes will be accepted until 5pm Jan 2 for the Extreme & 5pm Jan 9 for the Ultimate with a \$50 fee.

Payoff – 80% Progressive Payout – 1 Second splits. 70% of the pot to 1D & 30% to 2D. Pay off 30% to each go and 40% to average. Number of places paid to be determined by number of entries. Futurity Averages are determined by adding your run time from the 1st round & the 2nd round together & then a 2 second split determines the 1D & 2D winners.

**ALL FUTURITY CHECKS WILL BE PAID TO THE OWNER AS NOTED ON THE REGISTRATION PAPERS.  
THEREFORE, ALL OWNERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT W9 ON FILE WITH WRAPN3.  
ALL CHECKS ARE VOID 30 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE & WILL NOT BE REISSUED - Funds will be forfeited**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> go of the Futurity will be run in reverse order.

Futurity exhibits will be taken in draw order as posted. Each rider have 2 minutes in the arena as timed on the arena display. The rider will be given a 30 sec warning that their time is about to expire. If they have not left the arena at the 2 minute mark, they will be assessed a \$50 fine payable prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> go of the futurity.

All Futurity horses may roll over their times from the 1st & 2nd go rounds of the Futurity to the Open 5D main races held Saturday & Sunday. 1<sup>st</sup> go time rolls to Saturday & 2<sup>nd</sup> Go time rolls to Sunday. It is requested that Open Rollover entries be sent in with Futurity Entry. Rollover entries will be taken on site at the arena until 2pm Jan 3<sup>rd</sup> for the Extreme & 2pm Jan 10<sup>th</sup> for the Ultimate with a \$25 Late Fee.

Futurity VET or Doctor releases for entries will be refunded at the rate of 80% of entry fees only by Jan 25<sup>th</sup>. All Doctor or Vet releases must be received by Wrapn3 staff no later than 12pm of the Wed prior to the affected race. Releases may be emailed to snazzy1414@yahoo.com. There will be NO REFUNDS for STALLS or RVS. The contestant may sell their released Stalls or RVS.

**FUTURITY AMATEUR RULES:** Amateur Side pot requires a current AQHA or APHA amateur card. Amateur futurity is paid on a 2D 1 sec split format.

**ISABELLA QUARTER HORSES FUTURITY SLOT RACE:** Futurity Slot Race is separate from the futurity & is not rolled over to the futurity. The Slot race is paid on a 1D straight race format with a 100% payoff of entry fees. Payments to be made as noted on the Entry form and a horse & rider MUST BE named at the time of entry. Slot horses may be late entered until 12pm Jan 9<sup>th</sup> with a \$200 Late Fee. Late entries will be added to the end of the draw. Horse or Rider changes (but not both) may be made until 12pm Jan 9<sup>th</sup> with a \$50 change fee. **NO REFUNDS IN FUTURITY SLOT RACE FOR ANY REASON.**

**SWEEPSTAKES:** The Sweepstakes is paid on a 1D straight race format with a 90% payoff of entry fees. Payments to be made as noted on the Entry form. Late entries taken until 12pm Jan 9 with a \$100 Late Fee. Late entries will be added to the end of the draw. A horse and rider MUST BE named at time of entry. Rider or Horse changes (but not both) must be made by 12pm Jan 9<sup>th</sup>. The Sweepstakes cannot be rolled over into the open. **NO REFUNDS IN SWEEPSTAKES FOR ANY REASON.**

**YOUTH SUPER STAKES:** The Youth Super Stakes is open to any rider age 18 & under as of Jan 1, 2019. The Super Stakes will be paid on a straight race 1D format with a 90% payoff of entry fees. Payments due as noted on entry form. Late Entries will be taken at the arena until 1 hour prior to the start of the Youth Super Stakes with a \$50 Late Fee. Late Entries will be added to the end of the draw. A rider/horse combination must be named at the time of entry. Rider or Horse changes (but not both) may be made at the arena up to 1 hour prior to the start of the race with a \$25 late fee.

**NO REFUNDS IN YOUTH SUPER STAKES FOR ANY REASON**

**OPEN 5D:** 80% Payback of Open 5D Entry Fees. PRE-ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED in accordance with entry forms to be in the draw. NO LATE FEES & WALK UP ENTRIES TAKEN UNTIL THE LAST 50 RUNNERS EACH DAY. Contestants may enter the same horse twice & both times will count as a 2nd separate entry in each race. A rider and horse must be named at the time of entry. Rider or horse changes (but not both) maybe be made by completing the CHANGE FORM in the office 25 horses prior to the number affected & payment of the \$10 per day change fee. All other WRAPN3 OPEN RULES APPLY as noted at WRAPN3.com unless otherwise noted here or at the arena.

Open Awards will be given to the Open D winners of each day. The Open IS NOT an average race.

ALL OPEN CHECKS WILL BE PAID TO THE RIDER. THEREFORE, ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT W9 ON FILE WITH WRAPN3.

ALL CHECKS ARE VOID 30 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE & WILL NOT BE REISSUED - Funds will be forfeited

OPEN 5D VET or Doctor releases for entries will be refunded at the rate of 80% of entry fees only by Jan 25<sup>th</sup>. All Doctor or Vet releases must be received by Wrapn3 staff no later than 12pm of the Wed prior to the affected race. Releases may be emailed to snazzy1414@yahoo.com. There will be **NO REFUNDS for STALLS or RVS**. The contestant may sell their released Stalls or RVS.

**DERBY RULES:** Derby Horses are declared as follows: A horse whose Fut year was as a 4 year old, is then a Derby horse as a 5 & 6 year old of 2019. A horse whose Fut year was as a 5 year old, is then a Derby horse as a 6 & 7 year old of 2019. A horse that never ran as a 4 or 5 yo Fut horse, is a Derby horse at the ages of 6 or 7 years old in 2019. The Derby is run as a side pot of the OPEN 5D on Saturday & Sunday. Therefore, entry in the Open 5D is required and Open 5D rules apply.

**OFFICIAL PHOTOS AND VIDEOS:** The official Videographer will videotape each contestant's individual run, and entering the event will serve as your consent to the video and photo. These photos/videos are the property of Wrapn3 and its affiliates. Decisions made by Wrapn3 management as a result of viewing photos and/or video are final. By entering you consent to the use of your image and/or likeness of your run and participation for promotion of Wrapn3 Productions, and the official Videographer, and Photographer for any and all future use. Official Videos and photos will be available for sale at the event, and online after the event by the official Videographer and photographer and is subject to all copyright laws.

**GENERAL RULES:** Entry forms MUST be filled out COMPLETELY with the horse's REGISTERED NAME or YOUR LAST NAME FOLLOWING A BARN NAME. ALL WALK UP OPEN ENTRIES NOTED ON THE RUN SHEETS MUST BE PAID 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE RACE OR THE NUMBER(S) WILL BE RELEASED.

Open exhibits must be taken in the time frame you are registered in! We will NOT roll you to a later time. Please be ready! ALL EXHIBITIONS MUST BE TAKEN BY THE PERSON WHOSE NAME IS CALLED BY THE ANNOUNCER AS NOTED ON THE EXHIBITION SHEETS. Anybody taking exhibitions under another person's name will be fined \$5 per infraction.

Each contestant is responsible for RUNNING IN THE ORDER AS ANNOUNCED BY THE ANNOUNCER & RIDING THE HORSE WHOSE NAME IS ON THE ENTRY FORM. IF YOU RUN OUT OF ORDER OR DO NOT RIDE THE CORRECT HORSE AS NAMED ON THE ENTRY FORM YOU WILL RECEIVE A NO TIME.

Contestants will be given 3 gate calls by the announcer OR 90 seconds to get their horse into the arena or they will be declared a NO TIME by the announcer or arena director. You MUST CHECK IN with the gate person prior to your drag and be in the holding pen at least 3 runners prior to your run number.

ALL contestants must enter thru the designated IN gate from the holding pen or they will receive a NO TIME. NO EXCEPTIONS!

The arena director or Wrapn3 staff may have a NO TIME recorded for any contestant whose efforts or efforts of others to get a horse into the arena are declared UNSAFE TO ANY RIDER OR SPECTATOR or ABUSIVE to the horse at any time.

Wrapn3 WILL NOT TOLERATE ABUSE to a horse, UNSAFE HORSEMANSHIP or an UNSAFE HORSE by any person. Infractions will result in rider being asked to leave by the producer & any entry fees paid by the rider will be forfeited.

A NO TIME will be recorded for any contestant who knocks over a barrel or fails to complete the cloverleaf pattern as declared by the arena director or Wrapn3 staff.

During a competition run you get ONE ATTEMPT at each barrel. Any contestant who CIRCLES A BARREL TWICE or TAKES A SECOND ATTEMPT at any barrel will be FINED \$25.

Once You Are A PAID ENTRY in the OPEN you CANNOT change RUN NUMBERS or receive a refund for any reason other than a Vet or Doctor release as noted above.

We Run 2 Timers At All Times. If you have crossed the timer line to begin your run & you pull up because somebody yells for any reason or the timer display fails to work you will not receive a re-run unless the arena director declares you were fouled or BOTH timers failed.

All OPEN barrel races are advertised as a 5D format (½ second splits) and will be run in that format provided there are at least 125 horses entered. Otherwise the producer reserves the right to payoff in a 4D format (1/2,1/2, whole).

All CONTESTANTS OR OWNERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT W9 on file in order to receive prize money. Any money not collected after 30 days due to failure to complete a W9 is forfeited. 1099s WILL BE ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH IRS GUIDELINES.

When you pick up money at the window you must sign for it and COUNT IT. Once you step away from the window your payoff is finalized. It is your responsibility to count the money to ensure the amount is correct BEFORE walking off. Wrapn3 is not responsible for any discrepancies you claim to find later after leaving the window.

IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP YOUR MONEY THAT YOU WON ON FRI OR SAT AND YOU ARE AT THE RACE ON SUNDAY WE WILL WITHHOLD \$10 FROM YOUR EARNINGS FOR PROCESSING AS THERE IS NO REASON NOT TO PICK UP YOUR MONEY FROM THE PREVIOUS DAY WHEN YOU ARE STILL AT THE RACE. SUNDAY PAYOFF WILL BE MAILED IF NOT PICKED UP WITH NO PROCESSING FEE WITHHELD.

**ALL CHECKS ARE VOID 30 DAYS AFTER ISSUANCE & WILL NOT BE REISSUED - Funds will be forfeited**

There will be NO CELL PHONE USAGE in the holding pen and warm up pen areas. Users will be asked to leave.

Contestants are responsible for their behavior and that of others that they bring to our races. A contestant may be asked to leave if they or their associates do not conduct themselves in a respectful manner as deemed appropriate by the producer with no refunds given.

ANY AWARDS WON (NOT PRIZE MONEY) THAT ARE NOT PICKED UP AT THE RACE CAN BE MAILED UPON RECEIPT OF CREDIT CARD PAYMENT FOR SHIPPING CHARGES. THE WINNER MUST CONTACT WRAPN3 WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM COMPLETION OF THE RACE OR AWARDS WILL BE CONSIDERED FORFEITED. IT IS THE CONTESTANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO CONTACT WRAPN3 TO ARRANGE FOR AWARD SHIPPING.
